WHY THIS INFORMATION

LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

The personal data indicated on this page are processed by Castello Di Albola Sarl as necessary for the management of the site and, where required, based on specific notices and, if necessary, on the basis of consent to offer and perform the services provided by the site itself.

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED AND PURPOSE OF PROCESSING

Browsing data: The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this site acquire, during their normal operation, certain personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of the computers and terminals used by users, URI/URL (Uniform Resource Identifier/Locator) addresses of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.), and other parameters related to the user's operating system and IT environment.

These data, necessary for the use of web services, are also processed to:

- Obtain statistical information on the use of services (most visited pages, number of visitors by time slot or daily, geographic areas of origin, etc.);
- Verify the proper functioning of the services offered.

Browsing data does not persist for more than the time necessary to guarantee the functioning of the site and is deleted immediately after aggregation (except where necessary for investigating crimes by judicial authorities).

Data provided by the user

The optional, explicit, and voluntary sending of messages to Castello Di Albola Sarl's contact addresses, as well as filling out and submitting forms on the site, result in the acquisition of the sender's contact details, necessary to respond, as well as all the personal data included in the communications.

Specific notices will be published on the site pages prepared for the provision of certain services.

RECIPIENTS OF THE DATA

The recipients of the data collected following the site's consultation are the following entities designated as data processors pursuant to Article 28 of the Regulation:

The personal data collected is also processed by Castello Di Albola Sarl's staff, who act based on specific instructions provided regarding the purposes and methods of the same processing.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECTS

Data subjects have the right to obtain from Castello Di Albola Sarl, in the cases provided, access to their personal data and the rectification or deletion of such data or the limitation of their processing, or to object to the processing (Articles 15 et seq. of the Regulation). The appropriate request should be addressed to one of the contact details indicated above.

RIGHT TO LODGE A COMPLAINT

Data subjects who believe that the processing of their personal data carried out through this site violates the Regulation have the right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority as provided by Article 77 of the Regulation or to take appropriate legal action (Article 79 of the Regulation).
